

The Sr. Materials Planner's primary objective is to maintain customer service and inventory control both in finished goods as well as appropriate raw, packaging & WIP components with a focus on delivering total customer service satisfaction. This position entails production and materials planning and all execution activities. This position requires daily interaction with Honeywell's planning and control systems and manages the overall product supply chain to successfully maximize customer service while minimizing inventory and operating costs.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Prepare monthly/weekly production, inventory deployment and capacity plans developing and maintaining master production schedule to ensure proper flow of material across the product supply.

- Work closely and coordinate efforts with Operations, Sourcing, Sales, Forecasting and Marketing.
- Manage inventory levels for of Finished Goods, Raw, Packaging and W.I.P. categories.
- Reconcile negative inventory balances, issues with in-transits and, invoice issues, obsolescence and related transactions.
- Support project managers in planning the launch of new products.
- Take a lead role in using SAP to fullest extent in support of planning activities.
- Maintaining profile of suppliers in the supply chain, including and maintaining ABC classification for FG, order quantities, safety stocks, days forward coverage, lead time, and production rates.
- Report and resolve customer service issues promptly.
- Support Materials Manager in various analyses and other tasks
- New Product Development - 100% on quality, on time, on cost
- OTTR adherence - 93.0%

- Obsolescence FG and components keep under established target
